Synopsis: HB 282 amends the Public-School Code – Article 13 (Courses of Instruction and School Programs) by adding new subjects required to be taught to students entering the 9th grade as of the 2026-2027 school year. The new subjects embrace course content advising students of information on the following: employee rights in the workplace; Human Rights Act; the Public Employee Bargaining Act; the Federal National Labor Relations Act; and the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and labor organizations.
