<u>Section 1</u> amends Section 31-28-4 – entitled "Applications for Grants – Purposes – Conditions"

The Section is amended to delete one of the purposes for which a crime reduction grant may be made: "recruit or retain law enforcement officers, prosecutors, public defenders, corrections officers and mental health workers[.]"
