BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: RELATING TO SCHOOLS; ENACTING THE SEIZURE SAFE SCHOOLS ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SEIZURE DISORDER MANAGEMENT AND CARE BY SCHOOL PERSONNEL; PROVIDING FOR RULEMAKING; LIMITING LIABILITY.

There will be no fiscal impact for NMSBVI.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill seeks to implement more consistent practices to support students with seizure disorders, including having designated staff, providing training, and care plans. Due to the population of students we serve, we employ a health services department with multiple registered nurses on

both campuses. Any student with a seizure disorder already has a seizure care plan in place. Both classroom and transportation staff receive training and guidance from nursing staff, and are supplied with the care plans.
