BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: House Bill 310 (HB 310) is a proposal consisting entirely of new material that would establish a scheme and hierarchy for responsible disposal, repurposing, remanufacture, and reuse of propulsion batteries, a type of battery used extensively in electric vehicles. The scheme will impact auto recyclers, secondary handlers who will prepare propulsion batteries, secondary users who will repurpose such batteries, and specialized battery recyclers who will extract and refine useable material from the batteries, and will be housed in the environment department. As such the bill does not directly affect the Regulation and Licensing Department (RLD).
