Synopsis:

HB 310 aims to create a procedure for repurpose and disposal of end-of-life electric vehicle batteries and establish the responsible party for disposal of said batteries.

The bill also aims to prohibit disposal of propulsion batteries through landfilling.

HB 310 tasks the Environment Department with tracking and reviewing the sale, purchase, and exchange of propulsion batteries within the state.
