SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

HB 328 repeals provisions related to the Clean Transportation Fuel Standard (CTFS) program in New Mexico and prohibits the adoption or continuation of rules that establish such a standard.

Key Provisions:

- 1. Repeals the Clean Transportation Fuel Standard Program
 - o HB 328 repeals Section 74-1-18 NMSA 1978, which was enacted as part of the Clean Transportation Fuel Standard program under the 2024 legislation.
- 2. Removes definitions in Section 74-1-3 related to "carbon intensity" and Section 74-1-7 "fuel lifecycle" from the Environmental Improvement Act.
- 3. Prohibition of Clean Transportation Fuel Standard Rules
 - o HB 328 explicitly prevents the Environmental Improvement Board from adopting or maintaining any rules related to a clean transportation fuel standard.

HB 328 conflicts with SB 99 NO FUEL LESS-THAN-ZERO CARBON INTENSITY. SB 99 amends the Clean Transportation Fuel Standard program, Section 74-1-18 NMSA, by not allowing fuels to have a carbon intensity value below zero and HB 328 proposes to repeal Section 74-1-18 NMSA.
