SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

House bill 341 creates a new section in the Children's Code that requires CYFD to issue an identification card to licensed foster parents. The identification shall only be provided and be valid during the time that foster parents provide care for a child or youth that is in the department's custody. The bill specifies that provisional or temporary license holders are not eligible for these identification cards.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

CYFD will need to either purchase machines to print identification cards or continue outsourcing production to a vendor. If the bill does not require photo identification, CYFD can continue issuing the existing identification cards to resource parents upon licensure. Under the proposed legislation, new ID cards would need to be issued to all licensed resource parents which currently number approximately 1,732.

Since Licensing and Support Staff already handle ID cards issuance, no additional staff positions will be required. The department has plans to order 3,000 ID cards at a cost of \$5.00 per card.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

If the ID card is lost, stolen or misused, CYFD may need to establish policies for replacement and verification.
