SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: Requires that within 45 days of a child from a family in need of court-ordered services being placed in foster care, the department "provide for the child to receive a child and adolescent needs and strengths trauma assessment" and refer the child for services based on the assessment.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Fiscal implications should be minimal, as these assessments are already required to be done for children entering foster care under an abuse or neglect petition, and most FINCOS actions actually begin as abuse or neglect actions and become FINCOS actions after further investigation.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The title of the Act implies that a behavioral health assessment would be required prior to the child entering foster care. The language within the act makes clear that the assessment would be required within 45 days of being placed in foster care.

This statutory amendment basically codifies for children in FINCOS cases what is already required in the New Mexico Administrative Code, Section 8.10.8.17, for children in custody on an abuse or neglect petition, specifically that "to better understand the needs of the child and to make appropriate referrals to community providers[,] CANS assessments shall be completed by [the Protective Services Division], within 45 days of removal from the home."

It is important that the department be able to use the latest, evidence-based assessment tools. The inclusion of a specific assessment tool in statutory language could cause delays in the department's ability to implement the use of improved assessment tools.
