Synopsis:

HB378- Amends the Medical Malpractice Act to limit the amount of recovery for a medical malpractice claim to \$600,000 per occurrence. Limits a health care provider's personal liability to \$200,000, with any excess to be paid from the Patient's Compensation Fund.
