Enters New Mexico in the Emergency Medical Services Personnel Interstate Compact for the purpose of facilitating day-to-day movement of emergency medical services personnel across state boundaries and affording legal recognition to emergency medical services personnel licensed in a member state. The Emergency Medical Services Personnel Licensure Commission would serve as the national administrative body.

Specifies criteria for a state to participate in the Compact and for a licensee to have a compact privilege to practice in the remote state under its laws and rules.
