House Bill 436 (HB436) amends several acts: All Hazard Emergency Management Act, Public Health Emergency Response Act, Riot Control Act and Energy Emergency Powers Act. Requires that any order, rule or other directive issued by a governmental entity that closes or limits businesses or facilities must include exemptions for facilities operated by religious organizations that tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to the same extent as the most permissive exemptions given to other businesses or facilities.
