### **BILL SUMMARY**

### Synopsis:

HB479- Amends the Uniform Licensing Act to prohibit non-physician health care providers with a doctoral degree (e.g., clinical psychologists) from using the title of "Doctor" in any advertising or communication in a clinical setting without qualifying the specific profession in which they received their doctoral degree (e.g., Doctor of Psychology); violations would be grounds for disciplinary actions from state licensing boards including denial, suspension or revocation of the provider's license.

## **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

The NMMB endorses transparency regarding education and training qualifications of healthcare practitioners. Most patients associate the term *doctor* with physicians who are medically trained to diagnose, treat, and manage diseases comprehensively. Limiting the use of "doctor" to MDs and DOs can help reduce confusion about who holds primary responsibility for medical decision-making and patient care. The addition of specific professional designations would aid in transparency for patients and caregivers.
