BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

This act creates a mandate under the School Personnel Act that school employees report instances of gender incongruence in students to school administrators, who must then notify the student's parents and seek their input for a response plan. Gender incongruence is defined as a difference between a person's biological sex and their perceived or desired gender. School employees are required to report if a student expresses to the school employee that the student is experiencing gender incongruence, if the student requests the employee's participation in social affirmation of the student's gender incongruence, or if the student requests the employee's participation in the student's transition to a sex or gender different from the student 's biological sex . Administrators must notify parents and request their direction for a written response plan, which can include parental participation and support services such as counseling.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

HB501 does not provide clarification as to what constitutes requested "participation" in a students' transition to a gender different from the student's biological sex.
