SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 517 (HB517) enacts a new section of Chapter 21 NMSA 1978 requiring public post-secondary education institutions to provide free condoms to students. HB517 also enacts a new section of the Public School Code requiring school districts to provide free condoms to students in public secondary schools.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

HB517 does not allocate funding to public postsecondary institutions or school districts for implementing the newly amended Chapter 21 NMSA 1978, which mandates free condom distribution to students. Consequently, these institutions and districts must absorb the costs of providing condoms within their existing budgets, requiring internal reallocations of resources without additional state support.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Each public post-secondary institution's administrators, working with their student health centers and others, shall determine the best manner to make free condoms available to students.

Minimally, the locations for free condoms selected at public post-secondary institutions shall be placed in locations that are readily accessible to the students including student health centers and restrooms.

Each school district's local governing boards and governing bodies of charter schools will adopt policies to make free condoms available to high school students.

Public school administrators in consultation with the school nurses will determine the best manner to make condoms available to high school students.

Minimally, the locations selected at public secondary education schools and charter schools will be placed in locations that are readily accessible to the students, including the school nurse's office and restrooms.

No appropriation is made in HB517 to provide public post-secondary education institutions or local school districts to pay for the condoms that are expected to be free to the students.
