BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

HJR 22 looks to amended the New Mexico Constitution Article 2, Section 13. HJR 22 would add that a person can be denied bail if the person is charged with a designated dangerous or violent felony offense by a presumption and can be rebutted by a preponderance of the evidence.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Would reduce the time of pretrial detention hearing.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This would be a constitutional fix instead of a the usually statutory fix that clashed with the constitution. This will streamline pretrial detention hearing and make communities safer from individual that are alleged to have committed violent offenses.
