Synopsis:

HM29 requests the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee to examine current rules for applying for and renewing driver's licenses for people with diabetes, whether the rules can be revised to be less burdensome while maintaining driver safety in light of current medical science and practice and develop legislation based on the committee's findings.
