BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: This bill mandates that all members of the boards of regents of state educational institutions complete ten hours of training during the first year of their terms. Higher Education Department is tasked with developing and providing this training.

This requirement applies to all members appointed after the act's effective date, as well as current members with at least one year remaining in their terms, who must complete the training by December 31, 2025.
