Synopsis:

SB176- Relates to medical malpractice; requires 75% of punitive damage awards in medical malpractice claims to be awarded to the state and 25% of the punitive damage award to be awarded to the prevailing party; limits attorney fees; creates the Patient Safety Improvement Fund to be administered by the Department of Health (DOH); requires payments from Patient's Compensation Fund to be made as expenses are incurred.
