SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY Senate Bill 204 (SB204) would replace the provisions of the current Nutrition and Dietetics Practice Act, which would be repealed effective July 1, 2028, with new provisions regulating the licensure and scope of practice of a dietitian or nutritionist. The bill would create more specificity in educational requirements and examination for both nutritionists and dietitians and creats more of a distinction regarding practice regulations between the two. Dietitians would now have to have a Master's Degree to practice within the state. SB204 would create an Advisory Board and Fund. The bill calls for the repeal of the new act effective July 1, 2032.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

None for the Health Care Authority (HCA)

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The scope of nutritionists in this bill does include ordering labs and prescribing nutritional therapy independently. This may be an expansion of scope.

There is language in this bill that refers to a specific dietician guideline from 2024, *Revised 2024 Scope and Standards of Practice for the Registered Dietitian Nutritionist*. If this guideline is listed in statute, it will be difficult to adjust as that guideline outdates and newer research replaces that guideline. Consider removing from the bill and adding to rule or policy instead.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

A detailed analysis will need to be done at MAD to ensure our provider enrollment for dieticians and nutritionists aligns with the new Practice Act.
