BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: Senate Bill 214 (SB214) proposes to amend current law and introduce new statutes concerning programs and activities subject to the control of the Department of Agriculture, including pesticides, plant protection from insects, beekeeping, fertilizer, eggs, and weights and measures. The bill also adds or modifies fees, enforcement procedures, and penalties and makes grammatical upgrades. As such the bill does not directly affect the Regulation and Licensing Department.
