#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: This bill cleans up statutory language in NMSA 1978, Section 57-31-3, and creates a new subsection.

**Clean-up:** The bill makes minor modifications to Section 57-31-3. First, the bill removes a reference to "Section 5 of the Distributed Disclosure Act" and replaces that text with a citation to the codified Act. Second, it replaces the words "clearing house" with the hyphenated term "clearing-house." It does not appear that either change would alter the function of the statute.

**New Subsection:** Section 57-31-3 requires sellers of distributed energy distribution systems to provide certain information in writing to buyers. Under language added by SB 233, failing to provide this information would constitute a violation of the Unfair Practices Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 57-12-1 to -26 (2019).
