BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB238 is making an appropriation of one million four hundred fifty thousand dollars from the General Fund to the Public Education Department for expenditure in fiscal year 2026, for a Youth Behavioral Health Prevention Project for public school students. The proposed platform will provide online behavioral health education resources, pre-moderated peer-to-peer support services, and online private sessions with state licensed behavioral health professionals.
