### **SECTION III: NARRATIVE**

#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: Senate Bill 252 (SB252)

SB252 amends the New Mexico Telehealth Act, §§ 24-25-1 through 5 NMSA 1978, § 24-25-3, "Definitions" to expand the definition of healthcare providers authorized to provide telehealth services to include all social workers (not just independent social workers,) certified peer support workers, and the catch-all "any other health care professional who has received a Medicaid provider identification number from the health care authority."

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The Regulation and Licensing Department (RLD) does not anticipate any fiscal impact from SB252.

#### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

The Social Work Examiners Board (Board) is in favor of SB252 and the similar bill, SB12 because it will make mental health services available via telehealth to clients by all licensed NM social workers, both at the LMSW and LCSW levels.
