SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate Bill 283 (SB 283) is an act relating to children. SB 283 requires Children, Youth, and Families Department (CYFD) to determine eligibility for federal benefits for children in its custody, apply for the benefits and either act as the child's representative payee or determine an appropriate alternative for the child. SB 283 outlines the responsibilities and restrictions of CYFD when they are acting as the child's representative payee. It outlines that CYFD will assist the child with financial literacy and planning tools.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB 283 does not provide clarity on how CYFD will assess whether the child is receiving, or eligible to receive federal benefits. Health Care Authority does administer safety net programs that are federally funded. The programs are Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Medicaid, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), and Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). SB 283 does not identify the federal programs that they will determine eligibility for their children in the state custody.

ISD does not foresee any fiscal implications that would affect system enhancements or daily operations, unless SB 283 becomes clear as to how CYFD will determine eligibility for federal benefits.

A. Within sixty days after a child enters the department's legal custody, and annually thereafter, the department shall determine whether the child is currently receiving or is eligible to receive federal benefits.

Replace the strikethrough with:

the department shall assess if the child is receiving federal benefits and if not, submit an application to request such benefits.

MAD QB suggests giving attention to requirements to collect and manage the data that will be required in the mentioned report on page 3 line 21 of the bill.
