BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate Bill 305 (SB 305) is an act that creates the Quality Foster Parent Recruitment and Retention Task Force. The task force would consist of 13 members that are appointed to start their work by August 1, 2025, and conclude by July 1, 2026. The goal is to assess the broken system and improve on the recruitment and retention of foster parents. The task force should collaborate with an institution of higher education to perform research that supports the task force work, and they should study proven examples of successful models that work in other large rural states. This task force would be required to submit a final report at the conclusion of their research. Public Members of the task force should be eligible to receive per diem and mileage pursuant to the Per Diem and Mileage Act. SB 305 appropriates \$100,000 from General Fund to the Children, Youth and Families Department (CYFD).
