SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB 331 amends the following statutes to bring the language in these statutes into line with language in the statutes concerning battery against a household member (Section 30-3-15 NMSA 1978) and aggravated battery against a household member (Section 30-3-16).

- 1) Section 30-3-12, assault against a household member;
- 2) Section 30-3-13, aggravated assault against a household member;
- 3) Section 30-3-14, assault against a household member with intent to commit a violent felony;
 - 4) Section 30-3-17, multiple convictions of battery or aggravated battery;
- 5) Section 30-3-18, criminal damage to property or deprivation of property of a household member; and
 - 6) The penalty section of Section 40-13-6, concerning violation of an order of protection.

The new language for each statute concerns the offender being required to participate in and complete a domestic violence offender treatment or intervention program approved by CYFD; and an extension of the period of probation.
