BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate conservation committee amendment to senate bill 384 (SB 384) adds language specifying that the Rio Hondo watershed district to be created is in Taos County.

SB 384 gives an appropriation of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100.0) to the New Mexico department of agriculture (NMDA) to plan, develop and create a Rio Hondo watershed district in fiscal year 2026 (FY26).

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The amendment would have no fiscal implication to NMDA.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The amendment clarifies that the Rio Hondo watershed referred to in SB 384 is located in Taos County. There is another Rio Hondo located in Lincoln and Chaves counties.
