BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB 408 amends Chapter 13, Article 1 of the Procurement Act, section 154. The bill increases the contract amounts permitted for architectural, engineering and construction services that state agencies may procure on single and multiple contracts:

Multiple service contracts for multiple projects under a single qualification-based request where the single contract, including renewals, is increased from:

Six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) to two million dollars (\$2,000,000)

Multiple indefinite quantity construction contracts pursuant to a price agreement for multiple projects under a single request where all contracts under the single request proposal are increased from:

Twelve million five hundred thousand dollars (\$12,500,000) to thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000) in a period of no more than ten years

Architectural or engineering services in any four-year period is increased from:

Seven million five hundred thousand dollars (\$7,500,000) to fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000)

Construction contracts are increased from:

Twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) to thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000)

SB 408 does not directly affect the Regulation and Licensing Department
