BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate Bill 440 (SB 440) State Agency Language Plans is an act that makes an appropriation of \$250,000 from General Fund to the Department of Finance and Administration to support the State Agency Language Plans. This is to start in fiscal year 2025 and each year that follows. It states that any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.
