#### **BILL SUMMARY**

<u>Synopsis:</u> Senate Bill 452 would amend the Election Code to create the fourth degree felony crime of knowingly soliciting a person who is not a US citizen to register, or to vote, in New Mexico. Each act of solicitation is a separate offense. It is not a defense to the crime that the solicitation includes a disclaimer advising the person who receives it not to register or not to vote if the person is not a US citizen.

The Attorney General or a District Attorney may institute criminal proceedings for a violation of this act, and may request assistance from the Secretary of State or other election officials in investigating and prosecuting the offense.

Effective date is July 1, 2025.
