### **BILL SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis:

SB 460 amends the Investment in Films to Be Produced in New Mexico Act to define "Independent New Mexico Film Project". It also changes the allowed interest rate charged on loans against the incentive to be a range between zero percent and market rate and makes minor changes in language for clarification.

## **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

This loan program has not been used in several years; however, in the event it is used, there would be an effect on the severance tax permanent fund to provide loans according to the provisions.

#### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Although this program currently exists, no loans have been issued for several years. These amendments are unlikely to affect that outcome.
