BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate Joint Memorial 2 calls for the governor to be requested to appoint an "executive-wide task force" to study the needs of "frontier areas" of the state. The term "frontier areas" is defined in the resolution as "the unincorporated areas of a county that are sparsely populated and isolated from larger population centers and services and includes rural communities."

The task force would include representatives from specified executive agencies/divisions, as well as from frontier area communities, councils of state government, and any other agencies and service providers the governor deems necessary to ensure the study is done in a comprehensive and meaningful way.

The memorial directs that the task force study "the needs of frontier areas," and specifies several aspects of the study, including assessment of methodologies for strengthening frontier areas with financial investment, and incentives for areas willing to establish community-operated infrastructure networks.

The memorial further directs the task force to provide periodic reports of its work to relevant legislative interim committees, and a final report with findings and recommendations to the governor and the legislature by November 1, 2025.
