BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

(\$10,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the HAAWC→Indian affairs←HAAWC department HAAWC→of environment←HAAWC for expenditure in fiscal years 2026 through 2028 to plan, design and construct the Navajo-Gallup water supply project HAAWC→regional water line←HAAWC Beacon-Bisti-N9, HAAWC→Cutter←HAAWC Lateral HAAWC→and←HAAWC 371 HAAWC→/interstate 40←HAAWC HAAWC→regional water supply←HAAWC project that will provide a water supply critical to the community. Beacon-Bisti-N9 is a multi-phased regional project that will serve the following twelve Navajo chapters: Coyote Canyon, Tse'ii'ahi', Nahodishgish, Crownpoint, Becenti, Lake Valley, White Rock, Little Water, Casamero Lake, Smith Lake, Baca/Prewitt and Thoreau. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2028 shall revert to the general fund.
