AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT PROJECTS TO IMPROVE RIVER, STREAM AND WETLAND HABITAT AND SURFACE WATER QUALITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of environment ~~SCONC~~→for the department's river stewardship program←~~SCONC~~ for expenditure in fiscal ~~SCONC~~→year
