AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO ASSESS THE
POTENTIAL ACQUISITION BY THE STATE OF THE STAR AXIS SCULPTURAL
OBSERVATORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is
appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of
New Mexico highlands university for expenditure in fiscal years
2025 through 2027 to conduct a feasibility study to assess the
potential acquisition by the state of Star Axis, a privately
owned sculptural observatory located in San Miguel county,
including:

- (1) assessing the cost of legally necessary
upgrades required for public access;

1 (2) determining the long-term annual
2 operation, maintenance and staffing needs;

3 (3) outlining scientific and educational uses
4 of the site, including possible collegiate-level training in
5 partnership with educational entities throughout the state; and

6 (4) assessing the long-term value of
7 establishing a land art tour network for visitation of land
8 artworks in the state.

9 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
10 at the end of fiscal year 2027 shall revert to the general
11 fund.
