16	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION
17	A. Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is
18	appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of
19	New Mexico highlands university for expenditure in fiscal years
20	2025 through 2027 to conduct a feasibility study to assess the
21	potential acquisition by the state of Star Axis, a privately
22	owned sculptural observatory located in San Miguel county,
23	including:
24	(1) assessing the cost of legally necessary
25	upgrades required for public access;
