11 RELATING TO STATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS; REQUIRING STATE
12 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS TO PROVIDE MENSTRUAL PRODUCTS IN
13 CAMPUS BATHROOMS; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 21, Article 1 NMSA
17 1978 is enacted to read:

18 "[NEW MATERIAL] FREE MENSTRUAL PRODUCTS IN STATE
19 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.--

20 A. As used in this section, "menstrual product"
21 means a sanitary pad or tampon.

22 B. Menstrual products shall be provided at no
23 charge to students in each women's bathroom, each gender-
24 neutral bathroom and at least one men's bathroom in every state
25 educational institution enumerated in Article 12, Section 11 of

1 the constitution of New Mexico."

2 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--One million dollars
3 (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
4 higher education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2026
5 for disbursement to each state educational institution
6 enumerated in Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of the
7 New Mexico based on the proportion of female students for the
8 purchase and installment of menstrual product dispensers and
9 the purchase and distribution of menstrual products to state
10 educational institutions statewide. Any unexpended or
11 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2026
12 shall revert to the general fund.
