AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES; REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO EVALUATE THE IMPACTS OF UNIVERSAL BASIC INCOME ON PREGNANT PEOPLE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1. TEMPORARY PROVISION--UNIVERSAL BASIC INCOME PILOT PROGRAM.--**

A. As used in this section, "program" means the universal basic income pilot program.

B. The "universal basic income pilot program" is created as a two-year pilot program administered by the department of health to evaluate the financial impact on a pregnant person of providing a universal basic income from pregnancy through the first year of life of an infant.

C. The department of health shall develop an

1 application process for participants to voluntarily enroll in  
2 the program. The program shall consist of a control group of  
3 participants and a test group of participants. Participants in  
4 the program shall:

5 (1) be pregnant at the time of applying to  
6 participate in the program; and

7 (2) have an income at or below one hundred  
8 fifty percent of the federal poverty level.

9 D. The program shall begin on July 1, 2025 and  
10 shall end on June 30, 2027. The program shall proceed with the  
11 following limitations; provided that the control group shall  
12 not be subject to these limitations:

13 (1) the department of health shall distribute  
14 to participants a universal basic income of one thousand five  
15 hundred dollars (\$1,500) per month through the duration of the  
16 program;

17 (2) participants shall receive home visitation  
18 from employees of the department of health or an entity  
19 approved by the department of health;

20 (3) participants shall complete surveys and  
21 research forms throughout the duration of the program;

22 (4) participants shall attend prenatal care  
23 appointments with a health care provider as defined pursuant to  
24 the Public Health Act in a frequency recommended by the health  
25 care provider; and

1 (5) if a participant fails to comply with the  
2 provisions of Paragraphs (2) through (4) of this subsection,  
3 that participant shall be placed in the control group for the  
4 remainder of the program.

5 E. The department of health shall report the  
6 findings of the program to the legislative education study  
7 committee no later than December 1, 2027.

8 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--Eighty million dollars  
9 (\$80,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
10 department of health for expenditure in fiscal years 2026 and  
11 2027 to conduct a universal basic income pilot program. Any  
12 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
13 fiscal year 2027 shall revert to the general fund.
