11 RELATING TO CRIME; PROVIDING THAT IT IS A FOURTH DEGREE FELONY  
12 FOR A PERSON TO ENTER A RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT WITH THE INTENT TO  
13 COMMIT ANY FELONY OR THEFT AFTER RECEIVING NOTICE THAT THE  
14 PERSON IS NOT AUTHORIZED TO ENTER THE RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. Section 30-16-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963,  
18 Chapter 303, Section 16-3, as amended) is amended to read:

19 "30-16-3. BURGLARY.--

20 A. Burglary consists of the unauthorized entry of  
21 any vehicle, watercraft, aircraft, dwelling or other structure,  
22 movable or immovable, with the intent to commit any felony or  
23 theft therein.
