11 RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; REQUIRING THE PUBLIC EDUCATION
12 DEPARTMENT TO PUBLISH THE RESULTS OF THE DEPARTMENT-APPROVED
13 SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS FOR SCIENCE, MATHEMATICS AND ENGLISH
14 LANGUAGE ARTS; ESTABLISHING A DEADLINE FOR PUBLICATION;
15 REQUIRING REPORTING ON SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE AND TREND DATA;
16 REQUIRING USER-FRIENDLY PUBLICATION ACCESS; ASSIGNING DUTIES TO
17 THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

20 SECTION 1. A new section of the Assessment and
21 Accountability Act, Section 22-2C-14 NMSA 1978, is enacted to
22 read:

23 "22-2C-14. [NEW MATERIAL] SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS--
24 PUBLICATION DEADLINE--REQUIREMENTS--PERFORMANCE AND TRENDS.--

25 For the purposes of this section, "summative assessment" means

1 a department-approved assessment that is a single measure of
2 student performance at the end of a grade band. The department
3 shall publish the results of the summative assessments for
4 science, mathematics and English language arts. In publishing
5 these summative assessment results, the department shall:

6 A. publish the results provided for in this section
7 no later than September 1 of each calendar year;

8 B. at a minimum, include the following data:

9 (1) the overall statewide performance and
10 trends for students across all grade levels; and

11 (2) subgroup performance data that is
12 disaggregated by student demographics and is broken down by
13 grade level, including:

14 (a) race;

15 (b) ethnicity;

16 (c) socioeconomic status;

17 (d) special education status; and

18 (e) performance data broken down by
19 grade and subject for each school; and

20 C. publish the results in an easily accessible,
21 user-friendly format through a website or web page managed and
22 regularly maintained by the department and provide links to the
23 website or web page on the home page of the department's
24 primary website."

25 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
