## SENATE TAX, BUSINESS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL 533

57TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2025

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;

AMENDING THE NEW MEXICO BINGO AND RAFFLE ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE

USE OF CARD-MINDING DEVICES; REQUIRING REGULATION OF CARD
MINDING DEVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 60-2F-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009, Chapter 81, Section 1) is amended to read:

"60-2F-1. SHORT TITLE.--[Sections 1 through 26 of this act] Chapter 60, Article 2F NMSA 1978 may be cited as the "New Mexico Bingo and Raffle Act"."

SECTION 2. Section 60-2F-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009, Chapter 81, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:

- B. "bingo caller" means the individual who, in the game of bingo, draws and announces numbers;
- C. "bingo card" means a physical card or sheet with printed numbers for use in playing bingo and card-minding device representations of such cards or sheets;
- [G.] D. "bingo employee" means a person connected directly with a game of chance such as cashiers, floor sales clerks and pull-tab workers. A bingo employee may or may not be a member of a qualified organization;

- [H.] J. "distributor" means a person, other than a manufacturer, who provides equipment to a qualified organization but does not manufacture the equipment;
- $[H_{\bullet}]$  K. "educational organization" means an organization within the state, including recognized student organizations, not organized for pecuniary profit, whose primary purpose is educational in nature and designed to develop the capabilities of individuals by instruction;
- $[J_{\bullet}]$  <u>L.</u> "environmental organization" means an organization within the state, not organized for pecuniary profit, that is primarily concerned with the protection and preservation of the natural environment;

    - (1) with respect to bingo:
- (a) the receptacle and numbered objects drawn from it;
- (b) the master board upon which the numbered objects are placed as drawn;

- (1) educational, charitable, patriotic, religious or public-spirited purposes that benefit an indefinite number of persons either by bringing their minds or hearts under the influence of education or religion, by relieving their bodies from disease, suffering or constraint, by assisting them in establishing themselves in life, by erecting or maintaining public buildings or works, by providing legal assistance to peace officers or firefighters in defending civil or criminal actions arising out of the performance of their duties or by otherwise lessening the burden of government. "Lawful purposes" includes the erection, acquisition, improvement, maintenance, insurance or repair of property, real, personal or mixed, if the property is used for one or more of the benefits stated in this paragraph; or
- (2) augmenting the revenue of and promoting the New Mexico state fair;

- [R.] T. "manufacturer" means a person who manufactures, fabricates, assembles, produces, programs or makes modifications to equipment for use or play in games of chance in New Mexico or for sale or distribution outside of New Mexico;
- [S.]  $\underline{U}$ . "occasion" means a single gathering at which a series of successive bingo games are played;
- $[T_{\bullet}]$  <u>V.</u> "permittee" means any person issued a permit by the board;
- [U-] W- "premises" means a room, hall, enclosure or outdoor area that is identified on a license issued pursuant to the New Mexico Bingo and Raffle Act and used for the purpose of playing games of bingo or pull-tabs;

by the player to determine wins or losses or a gaming piece that is made completely of paper or paper products with an instant-win component that must be exposed by the player on a concealed card and can be used in a speed round for additional winnings utilizing a bingo blower. A "pull-tab" includes a tip board and can include a progressive pot;

[\frac{\text{Y-r}} \frac{AA.} "qualified organization" means a bona fide chartered branch, lodge or chapter of a national or state organization or any bona fide religious, charitable, environmental, fraternal, educational or veterans' organization operating without profit to its members that has been in existence in New Mexico continuously for a period of two years immediately prior to conducting a raffle or making an application for a license under the New Mexico Bingo and Raffle Act and that has had a membership engaged in carrying out the objects of the corporation or organization. A voluntary firefighter's organization is a qualified organization and a labor organization is a qualified organization for the purposes of the New Mexico Bingo and Raffle Act if they use the proceeds from a game of chance solely for scholarship or charitable purposes;

[2.] BB. "raffle" means a drawing where multiple persons buy tickets to win a prize and the winner is determined by the drawing of the ticket stub out of a container that holds all the ticket stubs sold for the event;

[AA.] CC. "religious organization" means an
organization, church, body of communicants or group, not for
pecuniary profit, gathered in common membership for mutual
support and edification in piety, worship and religious
observances or a society, not for pecuniary profit, of
individuals united for religious purposes at a definite place

"veterans' organization" means an organization within the state or any branch, lodge or chapter of a national or state organization within this state, not for pecuniary profit, the membership of which consists of individuals who were members of the armed services or forces of the United States."

SECTION 3. Section 60-2F-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009, Chapter 81, Section 6) is amended to read:

"60-2F-6. BOARD--POWERS--DUTIES.--

## A. The board may:

[A.] (1) grant, deny, suspend, condition or revoke licenses or permits issued pursuant to the New Mexico Bingo and Raffle Act, establish the terms for each classification of license to be issued pursuant to that act and set fees for submitting an application for a license;

B. The board shall promulgate rules to regulate the
use of card-minding devices in accordance with the New Mexico
Bingo and Raffle Act."
<b>SECTION 4.</b> Section 60-2F-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009,
Chapter 81, Section 15, as amended) is amended to read:
"60-2F-15. PERSONS PERMITTED TO CONDUCT BINGO GAMES
PREMISES
A. The officers of a bingo licensee shall designate
a bingo manager to be in charge and primarily responsible for
the conduct of all games of bingo. The bingo manager shall:
(1) supervise all bingo activities on the
occasion for which the bingo manager is in charge; [The bingo
manager shall]
(2) he responsible for the provision of any

- (2) be responsible for the provision of any card-minding devices to be used by bingo players;
- (3) be familiar with the provisions of the state laws, the rules of the board and the provisions of the bingo license [The bingo manager shall]; and
- (4) be present on the premises continuously during the bingo games and for a period of at least thirty minutes after the last bingo game.
- B. The bingo manager shall designate a game accountant to be primarily responsible for the proper preparation of the quarterly reports in accordance with the New .231230.2

Mexico Bingo and Raffle Act.

- C. For a bingo game, the bingo manager shall designate a bingo caller to be responsible for drawing and announcing the bingo numbers.
- D. The premises where any game of chance is being held, operated or conducted or where it is intended that any equipment be used shall at all times be open to inspection by the board and its agents and employees and by peace officers of the state or any political subdivision of the state.
- E. No owner or co-owner of the premises or, if a corporation is the owner of the premises, any officer, director or stockholder owning more than ten percent of the outstanding stock shall be designated as a bingo manager, a game accountant or a bingo caller."
