DECLARING FEBRUARY 10, 2025 "LAW ENFORCEMENT APPRECIATION DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers serve municipalities, counties, universities, tribes and the state; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico state police provides protection for the legislature while it is in session; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers face dangerous and difficult situations to protect their communities; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers may experience physical and mental health issues during the course of their service; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement agencies are lacking in resources to adequately perform many job duties; and

WHEREAS, in recent years, communities statewide have been experiencing shortages in law enforcement officers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 10, 2025 be declared "Law Enforcement Appreciation Day" in the house of representatives; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the chief of the New Mexico state police, the
