PROVIDING FOR TRANSFERS TO THE GENERAL FUND; DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. TRANSFERS TO THE GENERAL FUND. --

A. To address the difference between revenues to the  
general fund in fiscal year 1995, including the transfer  
authorized by Laws 1995, Chapter 30, Section 8, and fiscal year  
1995 appropriations, the following amounts are transferred from  
the funds specified to the general fund to meet fiscal year 1995  
obligations:

(1) seven million seven hundred fifty thousand  
dollars (\$7,750,000) from the subsequent injury fund;

(2) five million dollars (\$5,000,000) from the  
risk account in the public school insurance fund;
