AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONTRACT FOR A COST-BENEFITS STUDY  
FOR A DATABASE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred forty thousand dollars (\$140,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 to enable the public school capital outlay council to contract for a cost-benefits study. The study will establish a database to include available information about existing New Mexico public school facilities and infrastructure; accumulate and catalog national data, guidelines and standards; and enable assessment of the nature, quality and usefulness of existing information. The study will determine the costs and benefits of maintaining the database for local school districts

1 to use in conjunction with their local infrastructure needs  
2 assessments. The contractor shall present a completed report of  
3 the study with recommendations to the public school capital  
4 outlay council and the legislative education study committee no  
5 later than December 1, 1996. Any unexpended or unencumbered  
6 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to  
7 the general fund.

8 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
9 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
