AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR
STATEWIDE HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER CAREER INSTITUTE FELLOWSHIPS IN THE
MEDICAL AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Seven thousand dollars (\$7,000)
is appropriated from the general fund to the department of
health for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 to fund statewide
high school summer career institute fellowships to teach and
encourage students to enter the medical and health professions.
Expenditure of this appropriation is contingent upon obtaining
an equal or greater amount of matching funds from sources other
than state funds. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the
general fund.
