FOR THE LEGISLATIVE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE OR  
CONTRACT FOR SERVICES TO PERSONS WITH MENTAL ILLNESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS.--

A. Six million five hundred thousand dollars (\$6,500,000) is appropriated  
from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 to provide  
or contract for the following purposes in the following amounts:

(1) two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to expand the mental health in  
the '90s program, including expansion to communities with a small population of mentally ill  
persons, for individualized services for additional seriously disabled mentally ill persons;

(2) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to provide or contract for  
residential support services for seriously disabled mentally ill persons, including:

(a) services to communities with small  
populations of mentally ill persons;

(b) planning and accessing housing;

(c) security deposits;  
(d) interim rent and related housing costs;  
(e) supervised living expenses; and  
(f) demonstration projects;  
(3) one million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) to alleviate statewide waiting lists of seriously disabled mentally ill persons for psychosocial rehabilitation, case management and supported employment training; and  
(4) one million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) to expand outpatient mental health services, including services for the underserved Native American community.

B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
