AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO IMPROVE A STATEWIDE TELEMEDICINE
NETWORK LINKING RURAL AREAS WITH URBAN REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 to expand and improve a statewide telemedicine network that will allow rural health care providers access to urban medical centers through video and telephonic transmissions and that will improve rural health care needs by extending the telemedicine network throughout the state with the resources of urban regional medical centers. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
