MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION TO
FUND THE SEMICONDUCTOR WORK FORCE EDUCATION AND TRAINING
PROGRAM

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One million dollars
(\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
commission on higher education for expenditure in fiscal year
1997 for the purpose of expanding participation of community
colleges statewide and providing funds for instructors,
curriculum implementation, laboratory development, equipment
operation and maintenance support for the semiconductor work
force education and training program. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997
shall revert to the general fund.
