17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
20	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
21	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
22	Act in an amount not exceeding seventy-five thousand dollars
23	(\$75,000) when the state department of public education
24	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
25	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the

1 bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed 2 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 3 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 4 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 5 6 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 7 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education in the following amounts 8 9 for the following purposes:

(1) twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to purchase computer equipment for Ernie Pyle middle school in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county;

(2) twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to purchase computer equipment for Harrison middle school in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county; and

(3) twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to purchase computer equipment for Polk middle school in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county.

B. If the state department of public education has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.
