AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE  
DISTRICT ATTORNEYS TO CONTINUE FUNDING FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY  
AUTOMATION PROJECT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. One million eight hundred eighty-seven thousand  
nine hundred sixty-two dollars (\$1,887,962) is appropriated from  
the general fund to the administrative office of the district  
attorneys for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of  
funding the district attorney automation project. The following  
amounts are appropriated for the following purposes:

- (1) two hundred one thousand nine hundred  
dollars (\$201,900) to purchase computer equipment;
- (2) ten thousand five hundred dollars (\$10,500)

1 to upgrade the classification of one full-time equivalent  
2 position;

3 (3) eighty thousand six hundred dollars  
4 (\$80,600) to create two full-time equivalent positions at the  
5 administrative office of the district attorneys;

6 (4) seven hundred forty-nine thousand seven  
7 hundred forty dollars (\$749,740) to upgrade computer hardware  
8 and software for the administrative office of the district  
9 attorneys;

10 (5) twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for  
11 technical training for the district attorney automation project  
12 staff;

13 (6) two hundred seventy-nine thousand dollars  
14 (\$279,000) to purchase communications equipment for the district  
15 attorney automation project;

16 (7) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for  
17 computer user training for the district attorney automation  
18 project staff;

19 (8) ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) for  
20 special pilot projects related to the district attorney  
21 automation project;

22 (9) seventy-three thousand seven hundred ten  
23 dollars (\$73,710) for legal research;

24 (10) one hundred eighteen thousand two hundred  
25 dollars (\$118,200) to purchase laptop computers;

(11) seventy-six thousand four hundred twelve dollars (\$76,412) to purchase computer imaging; and

(12) eighty-seven thousand nine hundred dollars (\$87,900) to create two full-time equivalent positions and for operating and equipment expenses for the district attorney's office of the second judicial district.

B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
